I'm working for [RippleMatch](#), an easy career-matching service that gets students first round interviews at top firms like BlackRock, IBM, and Pfizer.

The premise of the service is that students take 5 minutes to [sign-up](#) and upload their resumes, then Ripple matches them with actively recruiting employers via a custom-built algorithm. **This means students don't have to hunt down job/internship opportunities – the employers come to them.**
